<p><u>1Th. 1:4</u> For we know, brothers loved by God, that he has chosen you,</p> <p><u>1Th. 1:5</u> because our gospel came to you not simply with words, but also with power, with the Holy Spirit and with deep conviction.</p>	<p>1 Th. 1:5b You know how we lived among you for your sake.</p> <p><u>1Th. 1:6</u> You became imitators of us and of the Lord; in spite of severe suffering, you welcomed the message with the joy given by the Holy Spirit.</p>
