GENESIS

God Created the heavens & earth (Gen 1:1)

Sun, moon & stars govern the earth (1:14-16)

Sun the greater light and moon the lesser (1:16)

. Darkness called night (1:5)

Waters called seas (1:10)

A river for the earth's blessing (2:10-14)

Curse pronounced (3:14-17)

Death entered creation (3:19)

Man separated – driven out of Eden (3:24)

Tree of Life guarded (3:24)

Sorrow & suffering enter (3:17)

Nimrod, rebel anti-God pagan king, founder of Babylon (10:8,9)

The rainbow, the token of God's covenant with the earth (9:13)

Marriage of the 1st Adam (2:18-23)

The doom of the old serpent pronounced. (3:15)

Abraham's seed extended to all nations and numerous as stars in sky and sand on sea shore (22:17)

“Why do the nations rage & the people conspire against God's anointed . . . For His wrath can flare up in a moment.” (Ps. 2: 1, 11)

REVELATION

A new heavens & a new earth the old earth passed away (Rev 21:1)

Sun, moon & stars connected with the earth's judgment (6:13; 8:12; 16:8)

No need for sun & moon – the glory of Lord provides light (21:23)

No night there (22:5)

No more sea (21:1)

A river of water of life from the throne of God (21:1,2)

No more curse (22:3)

No more death (21:4)

Man restored – “the dwelling of God is with men” (21:3)

Man has “Right to the Tree of Life” (22:14)

No more sorrow or tears (21:14)

The Beast, anti-Christ, the reviver of Babylon (13-18)

“A rainbow, [God's remembrance] encircled the throne” (4:3)

Marriage of last Adam – “For the wedding of the Lamb has come” (19)

The doom of the old serpent executed. (20:10)

“After this I looked and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and in front of the Lamb.” (7:9)

“The nations were angry; and your wrath has come” (11:18)
